Dear Association Members and Cemetery Neighbors:

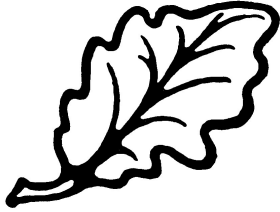
We wanted to take this opportunity to share some of our recent accomplishments with you. In 2006, the Mulkey Cemetery Association has:

- Been featured in articles and letters published in the *Register-Guard*, the *Eugene Weekly*, and the *Portland Oregonian*.
- Received a small grant from the Oregon Commission on Historic Cemeteries, a division of the State Historic Preservation Office, to cover graveling the turns at the north end of the cemetery road. This will make motor vehicle access to the cemetery for funerals and maintenance safer during the rainy season. Of 62 applicants, only 39 were funded this year, and ours was one of the very few projects which was funded in full.
- Continued to develop our web site at www.mulkeycemetery.org, including a section on New Burials.
- Developed guidelines for new monument installations which will help maintain the integrity of the cemetery's historic landscape. A brochure describing the guidelines is available by request from the cemetery administrator and board members, or online at our web site.
- Transitioned administration of the cemetery, along with cemetery files, from Kay Holbo to new administrator Sara Palmer, and shifted responsibility for management of the cemetery to elected board officers.
- Been managed without using pesticides or herbicides, representing our commitment to environmentally sound land stewardship.
- Hosted two neighborhood meetings to introduce cemetery-area residents to the new board of directors and explain the work we do.
- Increased fundraising. A big thank-you to everyone who sent a little extra this spring – it adds up, and it really does help!

This fall, we're planning workdays on October 21, 22, 28, and 29 and November 4, 5, 11, and 12 to get the cemetery ready for winter and put in new native and heritage plants. We'd be happy to see you there!
